

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-32

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska Legislative Bill #5, which takes effect on September 1, 2009 allows for the trapping of animals in the County Road Right-of-Way, and

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska Legislative Bill # 5, which takes effect on September 1, 2009 also allows for the County Board of Commissioners to pass a resolution to deny the right to trap in the County Road Right-of-Way, and

WHEREAS, the Boone County Commissioners feel it is in the best interest of Boone County not to allow indiscriminate trapping in Boone County Road Right-of-Way, and

WHEREAS, the Boone County Commissioners realize, that on occasion trapping of the Boone County Road Right-of-Way may be necessary to protect the traveling public from injury and Boone County Roads from damage

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Boone County Board of Commissioners that trapping will only be allowed by a licensed trapper, designated by the Boone County Board of Commissioners, on the rare occasion and as a last resort to minimize danger to the public or damage to a County Road. Any other person found trapping in the Boone County Right-of-Way without the specific permission of the Boone County Board of Commissioners, upon conviction could be fined a maximum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per trap.
